First Church is honored to welcome back the **Rev. Dr. Preston Davis** as today's guest preacher. As the VP & Minister to the University, Rev. Davis leads the religious and spiritual life of High Point University by shaping the vision and culture for Christian spiritual formation and interfaith dialogue and service. He is an ordained Elder in the Western NC Conference of the UMC, and has pastored Christian communities in GA, NC, and NYC.

In addition to serving the student body, faculty and staff as pastor, Rev. Davis regularly preaches throughout the region, and his writing has been published in *Charlotte* magazine, *The Charlotte Observer*, *Religion Dispatches*, *Union in Dialogue*, *The Term*, and *Infinite Space*. He received his B.A. from Davidson College, M.Div from Union Theological Seminary, and D. Min from Duke Divinity School.
